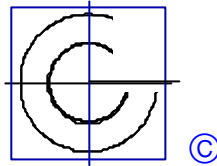

## ADVISORY NOTE No. 11

### **LABELLING REQUIREMENTS FOR RENDERING FACILITIES**

#### **Reference:**

- A. VMA email titled "LABELLING REQUIREMENTS FOR RENDERING FACILITIES" dated 16 November, 2001

#### **Background**

Recent nationally agreed changes applicable to the animal feed industry require suppliers and sellers of stock food containing restricted animal material (ie material taken from an animal other than tallow, gelatin or milk products) to label the stock food with the following warning:  
"This product contains restricted animal material - DO NOT FEED TO CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS, DEER OR OTHER RUMINANTS"  
The warning is also required for invoices or other documentation relating to the sale and supply of bulk compounded feed and meals that contain restricted animal material.

#### **Advice**

The Victorian rendering industry has been advised of these changes. The Victorian Meat Authority requires Auditors to issue a Critical Corrective Action Request to any licensee that is manufacturing stock food who has not implemented the above changes or in any case where the above requirements have not been met.

JAS-ANZ will monitor how this directive is implemented at the next surveillance visit.

#### **Applicability**

This Advisory Note is effective immediately and applies to the VMA HACCP programme. The Advisory Note will remain current until withdrawn.
