Background

As advised in JAS-ANZ Advisory Note 1/06, the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) issue, from time to time, memos to JAS-ANZ, formalising discussions with interested parties, for on-forwarding to accredited and applicant conformity assessment bodies.

To ensure that the memos are recognised and retained in the JAS-ANZ system, the DAFF advice will be reissued as JAS-ANZ Advisory Notes.
